Additional House Rules for Parents with Children

You must supervise your children at all times.

- Safe Harbor staff are required by State law to contact the Office of Children's Services (OCS) if children are left unattended, if we witness physical, sexual, or verbal abuse, or if physical, sexual, or verbal abuse is reported to us.
- Even if your children are asleep, it is **not** OK to leave them alone in your room, even if it is just to go outside for a quick cigarette.
- Teenagers who are younger than the legal smoking age may not smoke anywhere on the Safe Harbor Inn property.

Playing outside

- Children who play outside must have a parent outside with them while they play.
- Children may not play in each others' guest rooms. Children who want to play together can do so in the playroom or play area outside, as long as they have parental supervision.

Babysitting

- Safe Harbor Inn staff are not allowed to babysit for your children.
- Guests may not babysit for children who are not guests at Safe Harbor Inn.
- Guests may not hire babysitters to watch their children at Safe Harbor.
- Guests may not babysit for other guests' children.
- If you leave the Safe Harbor Inn premises, you must take your children with you.

Consideration

- Please make sure your children use good manners, pick up after themselves, and show consideration and respect for the staff, for other guests, and for the motel property at all times.
- Children are not allowed to disrupt the office, lobby, playroom, or other common areas with tantrums, screaming, or bullying behavior.
- Quiet hours are from 10pm till 8:00am. During quiet hours children should be in their rooms with their parents.
- Please make sure your children do not jump around, play in the halls, make noise, play the radio or TV too loud, or disturb other guests at any time—especially not during quiet hours.

Additional House Rules for Parents with Children

Use of motel facilities

- Children under 17 are not allowed to babysit for younger brothers and sisters or for any other children.
- Children under 16 are not allowed to use the kitchen without parental supervision.
- Children under 14 are not allowed to use the laundry machines without parental supervision.
- Children under 12 are not allowed to use the elevator or the playground without parental supervision.
- Children under 7 are not allowed to use the staff rest room without parental supervision.
- Children are not allowed on the Safe Harbor Inn premises unless they are guests or signed-in visitors accompanied by their parents.
- No shoes, food, or drink in the playroom. Children may not be left unattended in the playroom. Families who violate playroom rules will not be allowed to use the playroom for 30 days.
- Children are not allowed to ride bikes, skateboards, scooters, or similar vehicles on or near the Safe Harbor Inn property or in the adjacent streets or parking lots.

School

- If your children are enrolled in school, they must be ready for the morning bus and must attend school every day unless they are ill.
- Parents must be ready and waiting for their children when the school buses or other school transportation drop them off in the afternoon at Safe Harbor.
- All parents are encouraged to take advantage of the Anchorage School District's Title I (Child in Transition) program if applicable.
- Please make sure that you are at Safe Harbor to meet and supervise your children when the afternoon school bus drops them off here.
